### **The Estate Agency Affairs Board (EAAB) grants Continuing Professional Development (CPD) participants a final extension of time to register for CPD purposes**

#### **THE ESTATE AGENCY AFFAIRS BOARD (EAAB) GRANTS CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) PARTICIPANTS A FINAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO REGISTER FOR CPD PURPOSES**

The EAAB has received numerous requests from CPD participants (that is to say, all presently registered estate agents excluding only intern estate agents) for the grant of an extension of time within which both to register for CPD in 2016 as well as, where relevant, to register for the “catch-up” 2015 CPD programme.

After careful consideration of the matter, and with a view to assisting the relevant persons, the EAAB has agreed that the affected CPD participants, whether in respect of the 2016 CPD calendar year or the 2015 CPD calendar year for “catch-up” purposes, **be granted a final extension of time until 31 May 2016** within which to complete the required Personal Development Plan (PDP) and make payment of the relevant CPD fee for the calendar year concerned.

The grant of such extension of time for purposes of CPD registration is, however, made subject to the participants concerned agreeing that, should it not prove to be possible for them at this late stage to register to attend contact CPD sessions, they will be required to complete all CPD requirements by using the alternative CPD e-learning programme option.

CPD participants who have not as yet registered for CPD purposes are, therefore, respectfully urged to make full use of the last opportunity that is to be granted so as to ensure that they comply with their mandatory CPD obligations and thereby avoid not being able to accrue the required CPD points over the relevant CPD cycle since this will disqualify the participants as estate agents at the end of the cycle.
