PROCEDURE WHEN APPLYING FOR AN EQUIVALENCY EXEMPTION AGAINST THE NQF LEVEL 4 AND/OR 5 REAL ESTATE QUALIFICATIONS

Practice Note ETD03/2013 deals with the assessment of equivalency exemptions by the EAAB.

The fee payable to the EAAB for the consideration of each individual equivalency exemption application is the sum of R1260.00

If the applicant is a registered estate agent holding a valid fidelity fund certificate, such amount must be paid into the following bank account, namely: Account name: Estate Agency Affairs Board Account Number: 4052033310 Bank name: ABSA Branch code: 632005 Reference: Applicant's 7 digit reference number

If the applicant, however, is not a registered estate agent such amount must be paid into the following bank account, namely:
