ONE LEARNER ONE ESTATE AGENT PROGRAMME FEEDBACK

1. Background

The one Learner One Estate Agency Youth Brigade Programme is an initiative embraced by Estate Agency sector as far back as 2012 summit where each Estate Agency committed to recruit on learner/intern from previously disadvantaged background to address the Estate Agency sector transformation agenda. This was further emphasized by the Minister of Human Settlement during her 2015 Budget vote speech to achieve a goal of placing 10 000 interns/learners. The 10 000 Interns/Learners are to be placed over a period of 3 years as Follows:

2014/15-900

2015/16-2000

2016/17-3100

2017/18-4000

1. EAAB Achievement year 2015 to date

The Estate Agency Sector has recruited 6,109 learners from previously disadvantaged back grounds of which 2,871 are youth since 2012.

Further the estate Agency Affairs Board through the funding of SSETA has placed 798 learners during the 2015/16 learning period, 420 are still active on the Programme as at March 2016

We are busy preparing the graduation for our first phase learners with the DHS Office, around Aug 2016
